

#### inDICEs White Paper with Legal Recommendations

- Legal recommendations based on evaluative assessment of the impact of the EU Directive on Copyright in the Digital Single Market in the cultural heritage sector -> current framework
- Legal recommendations based on value chains analysis -> need for a new framework

- Copyright Harmonization
- Towards open legal concept of Cultural Heritage Institutions
- Exceptions and limitations to copyright for public mission activities
- Scope of text and data mining
- Public-Private partnerships

## **Beyond the current framework**


- Need for discussion on new policy and institutional solutions, including changing existing legal regulations allowing CHIs to fully exploit their socio-economic values
